#### TWENTY SECOND SUNDAY OF THE YEAR

The communities across our parish rely on the committed discipleship of their members. Whether it is our sacristans, catechists, readers, welcomers, faith-sharing groups, cleaners, those who visit the sick and housebound, flower arrangers, street pastors, those involved in all the different areas of charitable outreach or involved in ecumenical activities; whatever it is, our communities depend on them.

In this Sunday's Gospel Jesus tells us that if we want to be followers of his, we have to renounce ourselves, take up our cross and follow him. He goes on to say that anyone who wants to save his life will lose it; but that anyone who loses their life for his sake, will find it. I have always found this passage very challenging as I'm sure many of us have. What does it mean to "take up our cross and follow him" and what do we need to do?

For the early Christians, the cross would have had very special significance. Born into an age of Roman occupation, the prolonged suffering and death caused by crucifixion would have been very familiar and very powerful for them. With the passage of the centuries the horrors become less present to us and have less impact. We are very unlikely to suffer crucifixion but all of us will have to confront a measure of suffering in our lives as the price of being followers of the Lord. Each of us will have our own cross to bear.

For me, taking up our cross has to involve some element of denial of self, of self-sacrifice. Not to extinguish all joy and fulfilment in life but in a refusal to be drawn into a self-centred existence which is content to go along with the lifestyle and morals of our secular society. To be prepared to step out of our comfort zone and to stand up for what we believe in as baptised followers of Christ.

But our following must be done in the right way. Not for self-gratification, not necessarily for personal satisfaction but so that the message of Jesus Christ is made clear to all we come into contact with. Whether they are from our own communities, people drawn to us or who want something from us. Not doing it for our own sake but so that through us they get a sense of God's love for them.

We celebrate all those committed people who work for the glory of God in our parish. But the call is for every one of us to reflect on God's call, to come forward and to offer themselves. The *Called and Gifted* process in our parish earlier this year gave many the opportunity to discern God's call for them. But all of us need to be prepared to answer the call.

And to answer that call in the right way. In a way that is not self-seeking and self-regarding but that gives something of ourselves. As today's second reading from St Paul to the Romans says so eloquently: "Do not model yourselves on the behaviour of the world around you, but let your behaviour change...to discover the will of God and know what is good, what it is that God wants, what is the perfect thing to do."
