### **LENT**

It has been two months since we celebrated Christmas, and now the Church wants us to begin a new season, to remind us that we cannot stop at Christmas Day. Christmas is just the beginning of a journey. The liturgical year does not end at Christmas, it continues through Lent to Easter.

We have to imagine that after Christmas the baby Jesus grew, he left the manger and became a teenager and then an adult, and now, at thirty years old, full of energy and in his full maturity, he comes to us and challenges us, asking, "Who do you think I am?", "Follow me!", "Change your life!"

This is the beginning of Lent: Jesus asks us to make a choice.

While Christmas is the time of worship and adoration, Lent is the time when we are asked to say "yes" or "no" to Jesus. While Christmas is the time when Jesus is in front of us, Lent is the time when he wants to enter into us.

In Lent we are encouraged not only to see him, but also to choose him, to follow him, to have an adult relationship with him. Jesus is saying to us, "Follow me, be with me, listen to me, choose me, be like me!" This is also the meaning of the words that the priest says when he distributes ashes on Ash Wednesday, "Convert and believe in the Gospel", namely "change your goals, change your direction (this is the meaning of the word convert) and say yes to Jesus".

Lent offers us three pillars, three ways to grow in our relationship with Jesus Christ, to become more like him: fasting, prayer and almsgiving.

- 1. Fasting, that is, giving up something we like in order to understand what is really essential, what we really need in our life to survive, which is the Lord.
- 2. Prayer, which teaches us to acknowledge our need for the Lord and His mercy.
- 3. Almsgiving, to rediscover the joy of God's plan for creation and for each one of us, which is to love Him, to love our brothers and sisters, and the whole world, and to find in this love our true happiness.

This is the step that the coming weeks ask us to take: from the warmth of Christmas to the responsibility of Lent.

Pope Francis in his message for Lent 2025 challenges us when he says, "The Jubilee motto, "Pilgrims of Hope", evokes the lengthy journey of the people of Israel to the Promised Land, as recounted in the Book of Exodus. This arduous path from slavery to freedom was willed and guided by the Lord, who loves his people and remains ever faithful to them. It is hard to think of the biblical exodus without also thinking of those of our brothers and sisters who in our own day are fleeing situations of misery and violence in search of a better life for themselves and their loved ones. A first call to conversion thus comes from the realization that all of us are pilgrims in this life; each of us is invited to stop and ask how our lives reflect this fact. Am I really on a journey, or am I standing still, not moving, either immobilized by fear and hopelessness or reluctant to move out of my comfort zone? Am I seeking ways to leave behind the occasions of sin and situations that degrade my dignity?"


Please come along if you would like to grow in your life of prayer by praying with the following Sunday's Mass readings. All are welcome.

### Rules for Ash Wednesday & Lent

On Ash Wednesday (5th March) Roman Catholics must fast and abstain from meat. Fasting means reducing considerably the amount of food we eat (e.g. having just one meal) and abstinence means abstaining from eating meat. The law of fasting applies to anyone aged 18-60. The law of abstinence applies to those who are over 14. Roman Catholics must also abstain from eating meat on all Fridays during Lent.

Lenten Lunches in aid of CAFOD will be commencing this week on Friday 7th March and every Friday in Lent at St Edward's, from 12 Noon until 1.30pm. All donations will go to CAFOD'S funds helping all who are in need due to famine, climate change, wars and disasters. Your support will be greatly appreciated. There will also be a Lenten lunch in St Joseph's on Friday 28th March at Midday in support of CAFOD.
