#### The Sacrament of Marriage

This Sunday's Gospel is about marriage and the love between a man and a woman. When some Pharisees approached Jesus to test him, he replied: "From the beginning of creation God made them male and female. This is why a man must leave father and mother, and the two become one body. They are no longer two, therefore, but one body. So then, what God has united, man must not divide". Jesus is asking husband and wife to love each other with fidelity, to stay together no matter what, to live in unity.

We can ask ourselves: "What makes it possible for a couple to live in fidelity? To love each other all their lives?" I think there are two things that help a man and a woman to have a fulfilled marriage.

First of all, what helps a husband and wife to grow in their marriage is to recognise that the Lord has given one to the other so that each of them can walk together towards Him. In other words, husband and wife are not called to be a refuge for each other, but they are called to help each other find and follow the will of God, to develop a personal relationship with God. This means that each of them must find time to take care of their inner life, to reflect on their life, to grow in spiritual richness. The poet Rilke said: "Only two worlds that are wide and deep and individual can be united". Lovers can become one only if each takes seriously the relationship with the Mystery of Life, if each strives to develop a deep inner life.

The second help to grow in marriage is the practice of forgiveness. An authentic life together is impossible without forgiveness. It is important for spouses to learn to recognise the wrongs they have done to each other, to apologise and to forgive each other, taking the time to explain their behaviour and to understand each other's reasons.

Respect for the other is also important. Indeed, it increases the awareness that spouses do not possess each other, but are for each other God's free gift.

Forgiveness must be asked for by explicitly acknowledging one's own faults, and at the same time it must always be given wholeheartedly to the other. This may be difficult at first, but gradually the request and grace of forgiveness will become almost automatic. One will be able to recover more quickly from misunderstandings and will look at the other person and at oneself with affection, tenderness and irony.

No sin, if acknowledged and forgiven, is an obstacle to married life. In mutual forgiveness one experiences the truth of the words of Saint Paul: "Where sin increased, grace abounded all the more" (cf. Rom 5:20).
